GS.R. 690(E).—In exercise of the power conferred under Section 57 of the Delhi Development Act, 1957 (of of 1957), read with sub-rule (4) of rule 3 of the Delhi Development (Miscellaneous) Rules 1959, the Delhi Development Authority hereby makes, with the previous approval of the Central Government, the Regulations relating to the methods of recruitments in respect of one post of Deputy Chief Security Officer in (PB-2 + GP Rs. 4800).

The method of Recruitment, age limit, qualification and other matter relating to the post shall be as specified in column no. 3 to 13 Recruitment Regulations.

- 2. Short title and commencement.—(i) These Regulations as given in the schedule placed below may be called the "Recruitment Regulations of Deputy Chief Security Officer, Delhi Development Authority, 2011 (newly created post)".
- (ii) These Regulations shall come into force with effect from the dates of its approval by the Delhi Development Authority.
 - 3. Disqualification.-No person,
 - (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) Who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that Authority may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 4. Power to Relax—Where the Lt. Governor, Delhi is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do, it may by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing may relax any of the provisions of these Rules.
- 5. Saving .- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concession required to be provided for the Scheduled Caste, the Scheduled Tribes, the other Backward classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

सा.का.नि. 691(अ),—दिल्ली विकास (विविध) नियमावली, 1959 के नियम 3 के उप-नियम (4) के साथ पठित दिल्ली विकास अधिनियम, 1957 (1957 का 61) की धारा 57 के अंतर्गत प्रदत्त शिक्तयों का प्रयोग करते हुए दिल्ली विकास प्राधिकरण, कोन्द्र सरकार के पूर्व अनुमोदन से एतद्द्वारा अपर मुख्य विधि सलाहकार के एक पद के संबंध में भर्ती की पद्धति से संबंधित विनियम बनाता है, जिसका वेतन बैंड-4 एवं ग्रेड वेतन 8700 रुपये होगा।

वह उक्त पर पर नियुक्ति का पात्र नहीं होगा :

बशर्ते कि प्राधिकरण यदि इस बात से संतुष्ट हो कि यह विवाह उस व्यक्ति और विवाह के दूसरे पक्ष पर लागू स्वीय विधि (पर्सनललॉ) के अंतर्गत अनुमेय हैं और ऐसा करने के अन्य कारण हैं, तो वह उस व्यक्ति को इस नियम के प्रवर्तन से कूट दे सकता है।

G.S.R. 63(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 57 of the Delhi Development Act, 1957 (61 of 1957) read with sub-rule 3 of Rule 4 of the Delhi Development (Miscellaneous) Rules, 1959, the Delhi Development Authority, hereby makes, with the previous approval of the Central Government, the following Regulations regulating to the method of recruitment to the post of Chief Security Officer and Chief Vigilance Officer in the Delhi Development Authority namely:

1. Short title and commencement.-

- (i) These regulations as given in the schedule placed below may be called the "Recruitment Regulations" of Chief Security Officer, Chief Vigilance Officer, Delhi Development Authority, 2007.
- (ii) These regulations shall come into force with effect from the date of their approval by the Delhi Development Authority.

2. Disqualification. - No person-

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said post.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this Rule.

3. Power to relax

Where the Chairman, Delhi Development Authority, is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or posts.

4. Saving

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concession required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the other backward classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
