Sub: Minutes of 14th meeting of the Special Task Force constituted to address the various issues related to enforcement of Building Bye-laws and provisions of MPD-2021.

The fourteenth meeting of Special Task Force (STF) was convened under the Chairmanship of VC, DDA on 02.11.2018. List of officers who attended the meeting is annexed. During, the meeting the following was deliberated and decided:

- 1. The public grievances received through the various modes was reviewed by the Chairman, STF:
 - i) All the local bodies were asked to expedite the disposal of the complaints and timely update the ATR in the prescribed format on the respective portals. It was also conveyed that the numbers indicated against the ATR columns in the reports generated was far from satisfactory and the members were asked to ensure timely action/disposal.
 - ii) a. In order to ensure that a uniform ATR is generated, the members were informed about the format devised for the Special Task Force web portal which would ensure integration of the reports, currently being generated individually for complaints being received through the mobile app and through the offline mode i.e. through post. The portal would streamline the process and make it more user friendly. The format has been mailed to all concerned and all have been requested to revert with their observations and suggestions, so that the same can be finalised within a month's time.
 - b. It was informed that special fields are being created in the mobile app/integrated portal to ensure that the ATR's on the complaints being of specific nature pertaining to Traffic Police/Fire deptt. can clearly be reflected in the Composite ATR's prepared for all the agencies.
 - c. The list of nodal officers/govt. officers to be updated in the portal and the updated portal to ensure that the complainant cannot directly mark the complaint to the nodal officer.
- 2. The instructions for ensuring immediate resolution of complaints pending for more than three months were reiterated by the chairman and such complaints have to be brought to the notice of STF by the concerned DMC.
- 3. Issues referred by Monitoring Committee and discussed in the earlier meetings of the STF:
 - i) Kishan Garh Islam Colony, Nat Colony etc. and all non-development areas. It was informed by representatives of SDMC that in a joint operation with DDA, around 22 commercial structures were sealed in the Kishangarh area on 30.09.2018. The sealing in other areas i.e. Islam Colony, Nat Colony etc. could not be undertaken due to non-availability of police force. It was decided that the

sealing operation in these areas would be undertaken after the festival season of

Deepawali is over.

ii) North DMC was again asked to take immediate action for demolition of unsafe structures in Gayetri Colony, adjacent to Kathputli Transit camp as the removal of structures declared unsafe falls in the ambit of the local body. The stay on the demolition of the buildings granted by the court as mentioned during the meeting may be got vacated by North DMC in view of the above by moving an urgent application.

iii) Sealing of Sanjay Nagar Market, Mangolpur Kalan. The issue of sealing of unauthorized structures on Sanjay Nagar Market, Mangolpur Kalan raised by Monitoring Committee in its 127th Report Submitted to the Hon'ble Supreme Court was discussed. It was decided that in a joint operation of North MCD DDA and Delhi Police, after the festival season of Deepawali is over the commercial structures be sealed in the first round. The Police authorities to provide sufficient police force during the sealing operation.

iv) Local bodies to comply to the reference received from the MC regarding sealing of the Motels.

v) All the local bodies, DDA and Delhi Jal Board were asked to submit a detailed report regarding removal of encroachment for rejuvenation of the water bodies.

- 4. The local bodies/govt. agencies were asked to take immediate action against the erring officers/officials against whom the complaints seeking disciplinary actions have been received.
- 5. It was brought to the notice of the Chair by the member of the local body that various applications for closing/cancellation of the complaints are received by the complainants. In this regard, the Chairman, STF directed that once a complaint has been received, it shall be closed by the concerned Nodal/Grid officer after it has been completely examined as per the law.
- 6. One of the members of North-DMC informed that the demolition action in the matter of illegal extension made by Shop No. 3 Cascade complex, Netaji Subhash Place which was placed in the 13th meeting of the STF pertains to DDA. Accordingly, DDA was directed to take immediate cognizance in the matter.
- 7. It was deliberated that a separate ATR may also be placed before the meeting regarding actions taken by the concerned local bodies / govt. agencies other than the action taken under the mandate of STF. The chairman STF requested all the members that Nodal officers/Grid officers should take proactive action for removal of unauthorized construction, if notified without waiting for it to be reported. The members informed that the Sealing/demolition actions reported do not clearly reflect the actions being taken by the local bodies. It was therefore decided that henceforth to get an overview of the actions being taken by all the concerned for Sealing/demolition in respect of unauthorized construction, a separate status/ATR of cases not covered under the purview of STF would be tabled in the meeting of the STF.
- 8. The cases pending for long time and involving court directions for submission of Action Taken Report were discussed in the meeting and the status is as follows:



- i) Jagpal Singh vs GNCTD and ANR [WP(C) No. 11410/2015] wherein Hon'ble High Court Delhi vide its order dated 23.05.2017 has directed DDA to remove illegal encroachment over the pond situated in Badarpur Village, South-East Delhi.
- ii) Sh. Subodh Kumar Wadhwa regarding misuse of premise No. C-1, C-1/1 and C-1/2, Ring Road, Nariana, New Delhi (North DMC).
- iii) Sh. P.C. Pande regarding damaging the balcony of the complainant for protecting the encroachment by distorting the facts (North DMC).
- iv) Dr. Manjula Krippendorf, regarding demolition of structurally unsafe illegal building (as per health assessment done by MAC Consulting Engineers) at B-56, Defence Colony, New Delhi (South DMC).
- v) Complaint received from Encroachment Control wherein it has sought disciplinary action against responsible officers/officials (North DMC).
- vi) Grievance submitted by Dabri Ext. East RWA regarding encroachment on pedestrian way by peddlers/shopkeepers at Dabri Mor to Kailashpuri Road, Sagarpur (South DMC).
- vii)Encroachment of DDA land at T-2411, Guru Nanak Market Karol Bagh (Engg. Deptt./LM Deptt., DDA).
- viii)Sh. Raj Kapoor regarding delay in compliance of demolition order issue by North DMC to property No. A-298, Prashant Vihar, Rohini.
- ix) Prof. Imtiyaz Ahmad regarding encroachment on colony road and service lanes by builder mafai in connivance with the officials of SDMC (Najaf Garh Zone) and Delhi Police (PS Vasant Kunj, South).

Chairman STF, directed all the concerned deptt./officers to examine the above matters on top priority and submit the ATR within one week so that the same can be discussed during the STF meeting.

9. The agenda for the meeting of STF henceforth to be circulated at least two days in advance.

The next meeting is scheduled to be held on **16.11.2018** at **02:30 pm** for which no separate meeting notice will be issued. All the members of the STF are requested to attend the meeting in person.

Meeting ended with the thanks to the chair.
