RangBaag is a joint initiative between DDA and NSD to bring theatre education to public spaces and make it accessible to children in the community. The workshop will engage participants through a range of theatre-based activities, including communication exercises, movement-based activities, storytelling, improvisation, and basic performance techniques.

The workshop aims at the social integration of children to sensitize themselves towards their surroundings through theatre activities in a play-way method. It will culminate in a **final performance on 14th June 2026**, where participants will showcase their learning.

RangBaag is inviting applications for its first batch. The application can be filled online, and admissions will be given to **30 students** on “**First Come, First Serve**” basis.

Age of the applicant must be between 12 to 16 years as of 1st May 2026.

How to apply –

The application forms can be filled up online through our website: www.dda.gov.in. Admissions are open from **7th April to 24th April 2026 (5:00 PM)**. Applicants will be required to upload self-attested copies of **birth certificate, certificate of SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/EWS/BPL (if applicable)**. Please bring original documents of these certificates at the time of first day of workshop.

Incomplete application forms will not be entertained.

Selection of candidates shall be based on scrutiny and verification of submitted documents. DDA and NSD reserve the right to accept or reject any application at their discretion, and their decision shall be final and binding.



Important points to note –

- Seats are limited. The total numbers of seats are **30 seats** in the group. The application will be accepted on “First Come First Serve Basis only”, subject to verification of eligibility.
- The list of admitted candidates will be displayed on our website www.dda.gov.in on **27th April 2026 by 5:00 PM**.
- Selected candidates will be required to complete the payment through a designated QR code, the details of which will be shared along with the final list of selected candidates. The payment window will open from **27th April (5:00 PM)** to **1st May (5:00 PM)**. In case a selected candidate fails to complete the payment within the stipulated time, the seat may be offered to the next eligible applicant.
- Participants must report on the first day of the workshop with proof of payment / payment receipt and original documents for verification.
- Participants will not be required to pay the entry fee at Baansera Park on the first day upon showing their payment receipt. For subsequent days, participants must carry and present their ID cards (which will be issued on the first day), to avail free entry.
- The participants are required to join sessions regularly. Continued participation is subject to regular attendance. Repeated absence without prior intimation may result in the seat being offered to another participant.
- Participants are expected to report on time. Late entry may not be permitted once the session has commenced.
- All candidates are required to submit complete and correct information and documents. Applications found to be incomplete or containing incorrect information are liable to be rejected.
- An application processing fee of Rs. 100/- shall be payable at the time of submission. The processing fee will be adjusted for candidates who are selected and participate in the programme. However, the application processing fees paid by the participants will not be refundable in case of rejection of forms due to incorrect information /documents, or non-selection.
- DDA reserves the right to fill any vacancies arising due to rejection of applications. Admissions will continue to be offered on a first come, first served basis.
- For selected participants, workshop fee paid shall be non-refundable, except in cases of programme cancellation by the organizers.
- The centre for workshop is fixed and cannot be changed for any reason.
- Participants are required to manage their own transportation and meals/snacks.
- Participants are advised to carry water bottles, caps, and wear comfortable clothing suitable for outdoor activities.
- RangBaag is proposed to be conducted in an open park environment and may involve light physical and creative activities. Parents/guardians are advised to



ensure that children take appropriate precautions, including adequate hydration, appropriate clothing, and that the child is in suitable health to participate. While DDA and NSD will take all reasonable measures to ensure a safe and supervised environment, they shall not be responsible for any health issues arising due to heat-related conditions or where a child is not in adequate health to participate in such activities.

- Participants are expected to maintain discipline and respectful behaviour towards instructors and fellow participants. Any form of disruptive or unsafe conduct may lead to discontinuation from the programme.
- Photographs and videos of the sessions and performances may be captured for documentation and promotional purposes by DDA and NSD. Participation in the programme will be deemed as consent for the same, unless otherwise specified by the parent/guardian.

Workshop Fee –

1. The fee for children applying in unreserved category is **Rs. 5000/- only per participant.**
2. The applicable fee for children belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-creamy layer), EWS categories is **Rs. 1250/- per participant** and will be required to produce an original copy of the caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC) and income proof (EWS).
