## HON'BLE LG LAUNCHED LMIS PORTAL OF DDA

- LG launched the LMIS portal of DDA; stresses upon minimum human interface and intervention in management of land records.
- LMIS will standardize all the processes involved in the functioning of the Land Management Department, making the entire system digitized.
- It will help in maintaining land inventory of all lands under DDA and effectively manage court cases.
- People will now be able to do online self-registration & assess damage charges and pay charges online.



The Lt. Governor of NCT Delhi, Shri V. K. Saxena today launched a web based portal viz. Land Management Information System (LMIS) aimed at Digital maintenance of land records and effective as well as efficient management and protection of Delhi Development Authority (DDA) land. The portal will be helpful in facilitating various functional verticals of the Land Management Department of DDA on a single platform through 11 Modules such as Land Inventory, Encroachment detection and demolition module, Damage Payee Module etc.

Speaking on the occasion, Shri Saxena emphasized upon the need of complete digitization of land records and instructed the DDA to ensure zero human interface and intervention in this regard at the earliest. As a citizen centric approach, the LMIS will ensure online self-registration & assessment of damage charges by occupants and online damage collection. The software will also be helpful in the effective disposal of various Land Management Department tasks such as maintenance of Land Inventory of all lands under DDA, management of court cases, new land acquisition records, related land documents, file data Loading (Record room management) and GIS module etc.

The LMIS software will standardize all the processes involved in the functioning of the Land Management Department and make the entire system digitized leading to more efficiency.

## HON'BLE LG INAUGURATED 2 COMMUNITY HALLS AT SECTOR 18 & 19, ROHINI

- Community Halls inaugurated at Rohini to be named after Sardar Patel; Lt Governor urges people to use the facilities
- Community halls to provide facilities for social, cultural, religious and marriage ceremonies.
- Built at Rs. 11.30 crore, these halls are equipped with a party hall, library, gymnasium, lifts, senior citizen room, children play area, and parking facilities.



Aimed at ensuring "ease of living" to the people, Shri V K Saxena, Hon'ble Lt Governor, Delhi today inaugurated two community halls at Sector 18 & Sector 19, Rohini and named them after Sardar Patel as a tribute, on the occasion of his Jayanti. General people can use them for their social, cultural, religious and marriage ceremonies at affordable rates. Delhi Development Authority has constructed both these community halls at a cost of Rs.11.30 crore.

Shri Vijender Gupta, Hon'ble MLA, and Member DDA, and Shri Manish Kumar Gupta, Vice-chairman DDA were also present on the occasion.

Speaking on the occasion, the Lt Governor said that Hon'ble Prime Minister has given an opportunity to Delhi to host the G20 summit where representatives of various countries will be coming to the national capital. "We should show the world that Delhi is not only the capital of the country but is also an excellent host, committed to its guests," he said.

He announced that these Community Halls will be named after Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel (on the request of Shri Vijender Gupta) paying tribute to India's first home minister on his birth anniversary.

The Lt Governor said that community halls are important for the society, especially the not so well off sections, for their social functions as these people can't afford big hotels, farm houses. He urged people to make use of the various facilities and applauded the efforts of DDA in developing the infrastructure of the city.

The community halls, equipped with a party hall, library, gymnasium, lifts, senior citizen room, children play area, parking facilities, among others, will be very useful for around 50000 people who live in these sectors. There are 3 party halls in the



community hall at Sector 18, which has the capacity of 150 people each. In the community hall at Sector 19, the party hall has the capacity of about 60 persons.

Besides, DDA is also developing a socio-cultural centre in Sector 10, Rohini on PPP model. This centre, spread over 11 acres, is likely to be completed in the next three years. Earlier this year, three air-conditioned community halls were inaugurated at Sector 7, 8 & 15 in Rohini. With the coming up of these projects, people of Rohini will be highly benefited.

03.11.22: A half-day workshop was organised along with a debate competition

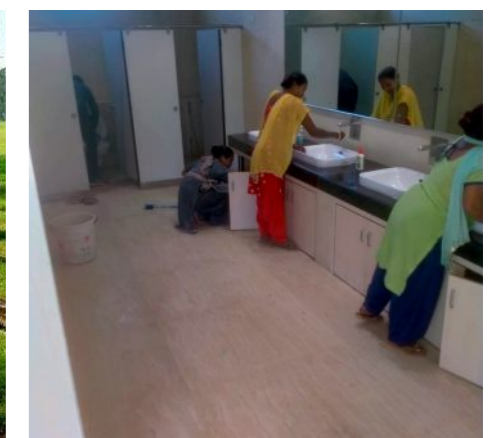
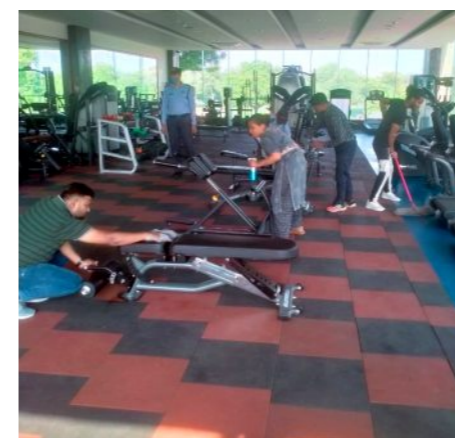
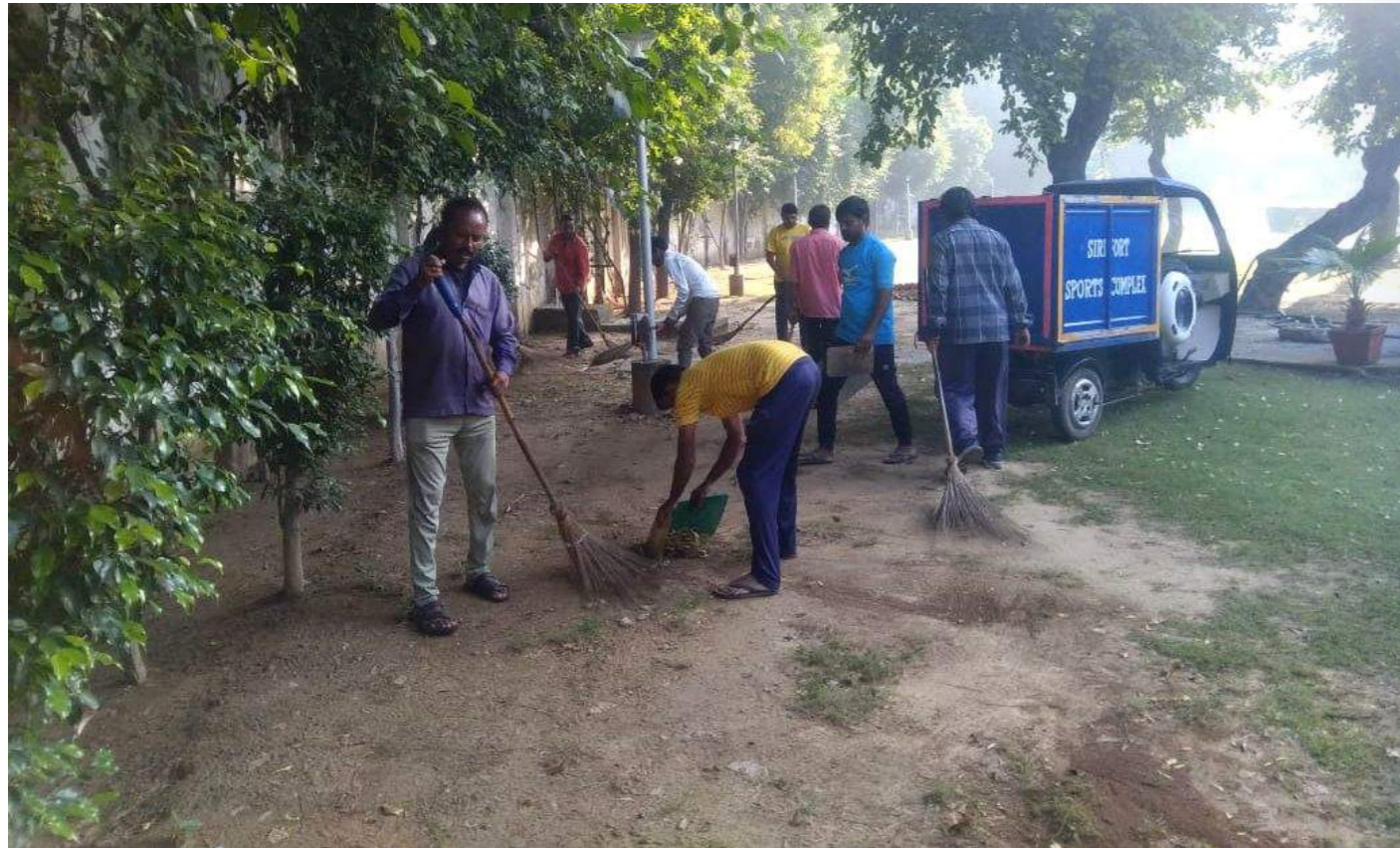
04.11.22: The winners of the events were awarded certificates and prizes at the closing ceremony
