# HON'BLE LT. GOVERNOR DELHI LAYS FOUNDATION STONE OF SPORTS COMPLEX AT QUTABGARH



In line with the Hon'ble Prime Minister's vision of ease of living and to promote healthy lifestyle, Shri Vinai Kumar Saxena, Lt. Governor Delhi, laid foundation stone of a sports complex at Qutabgarh Village on 03.10.2023. The village has been adopted by Hon'ble Lt Governor to develop it as a model village.

Shri Hans Raj Hans, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, North West Delhi, Shri Vijender Gupta, Hon'ble MLA Rohini, Shri Naresh Kumar, Chief Secretary Delhi and Shri Subhashish Panda, Vice Chairman, DDA were also present on the occasion.

Sports complex at Qutabgarh village to have multiple sporting facilities like Akhara for males and females, kabaddi ground, jogging track, open gym, badminton court, volleyball court.

Water body also inaugurated; will aid farming and other groundwater allied activities.

Other villages to be also developed, DDA to be allocated Rs 800 crores.



The project, slated to be completed by next month, will have multiple sporting facilities like Akhara for male and female wrestlers, kabaddi ground, jogging track, open gym, badminton court, volleyball court, among others.

Speaking on the occasion, Hon'ble Lt Governor reiterated his commitment to upgrade and furnish all 49 rural villages in the National Capital with the best of civic infrastructure and said that the sports complex will be highly beneficial for the youth of Qutabgarh and nearby villages. He urged people to avail various facilities provided by it, once it is completed.

He said that other villages will also be transformed on the lines of Qutabgarh Village, adding that 49 villages would be developed at the estimated cost Rs 800 crore, for which fund will be allocated to DDA. Shri Saxena also visited Jaunti Village to review developmental works undertaken in the village, including a proposed sports complex, which is likely to be completed by January 2024.







The Hon'ble Lt Governor also inaugurated and dedicated a water body to the residents of the village. This water body will aid farming and other groundwater allied activities in the village. Deepening and de-silting of the water body was undertaken and is now fit for rainwater to be collected in it, instead of overflowing in drains.

Besides, footpath has been constructed around the water body and plantation work has also been completed, which will not only beautify the village but will also promote physical well-being among the villagers as they can enjoy morning and evening walks around the water body and keep themselves fit.

To encourage artisans who make beautiful environment-friendly clay utensils, Hon'ble Lt Governor distributed electric potter wheels to them while appreciating their hard work.

Shri Subhashish Panda, Vice Chairman DDA said that many developmental works are being undertaken by DDA to transform the lives of the residents of Delhi and he assured that DDA will continue to work with more zeal and enthusiasm.

DDA has played a pivotal role in building sports infrastructure and promotion of sports in the national capital. At present, DDA has 16 sports complexes, 3 mini sports complexes, 2 public golf courses, 17 swimming pools and 40 multigyms.

Besides, Centres of Excellence are being developed in many sports like wrestling, weight lifting, boxing, judo, kabaddi, tennis, shooting, football, hockey in various sectors of Dwarka and Centre of Excellence in aquatics in Sector 33 Rohini. A public golf course is also being developed at Sector 24 Dwarka.







# UNVEILING OF RESTORED HERITAGE STRUCTURES AT MEHRAULI ARCHAEOLOGICAL PARK BY HON'BLE LT. GOVERNOR DELHI



In line with the vision of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi to promote 'Vikas Bhi, Virasat Bhi', Shri Vinai Kumar Saxena, Hon'ble Lt Governor Delhi on 20.10.2023, unveiled restored heritage structures at Mehrauli Archaeological Park as part of the Government's mission to conserve Delhi's rich heritage and its ancient glory.

The restoration works include transformation of Quli Khan Tomb, Balban Tomb complex, Metcalf Boathouse, rejuvenated water body, and illuminated monuments.

At least 55 heritage monuments have been interconnected with a pathway.

Smt. Meenakshi Lekhi, Hon'ble Minister of State for Culture, Government of India, and Shri Subhasish Panda, Vice Chairman, DDA were also present on the occasion.

The LG had been personally monitoring the entire project and several coordination meetings were held under his supervision to resolve various pending issues, ensuring proper coordination among various departments. All the works were completed in record time due to the regular monitoring and site inspections by the LG.

Hon'ble Lt Governor said, "Within 6 to 7 months, this place has transformed. People of Delhi deserve good places where they can spend leisure time with their family and we are making all efforts to revive heritage places." The cost of the project is approximately Rs 2.6 crore.

The Mehrauli Archaeological Park now boasts of restored and conserved heritage structures including Balban's Tomb complex, which was once completely covered










with weeds. It has improved landscaping and additional greens in and around restored historic structures. Vantage points have been created for mesmerizing view of Qutub Minar from the park. Similarly, Quli Khan Tomb which was lying in a dilapidated state, has been restored with intricate interior works. The monuments have been interconnected with pathway and access has been given to all the 55-heritage structures of the park, which was earlier missing.

The Park also has rejuvenated water body near Metcalfe Boathouse with aerator fountains, cascade and illumination. Besides, important heritage structures/monuments have also been illuminated. There are adequate public amenities for visitors to spend leisure time in the park.

The restoration and conservation works have been done on the principles of heritage conservation maintaining the authenticity and structural integrity of the structures. Also, suitable adaptive reuses have been proposed to enhance the visitors experience and to preserve the historical and cultural value of heritage structures while giving them new functions and uses as per the global practice.

The Masterplan, 2021 and Unified Building Bye Laws, 2016 of Delhi immensely promotes the adaptive re-use of historic buildings and this principle has been applied in the park. The restoration and repair work has been carried out using the traditional materials and techniques Lime Surkhi, prepared using Ural dal and other organic additives.

DDA has been playing pivotal role in restoring the heritage structures in the National Capital. Conservation of St. James Church and Hazrat Nizamuddin Basti Renewal are some of the other projects undertaken by DDA recently.







### **DDA CONDUCTS MASSIVE CLEANLINESS DRIVE UNDER:**

### I. ONE HOUR OF SHRAMDAAN FOR SWACHHATA' AT 75 LOCATIONS

Responding to Hon'ble Prime Minister's appeal for "one hour of shramdaan for swachhata", DDA conducted a massive cleanliness drive at various locations in Delhi on 01.10.2023 from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m. with general public and RWAs as a tribute to Father of the Nation.

DDA is working relentlessly for Green Delhi, Clean Delhi. Shri Vinai Kumar Saxena, Hon'ble Lt Governor Delhi personally monitored the cleanliness drive and directed DDA to make this movement a grand success.

For monitoring the campaign, nodal officers were appointed and officers of the rank of Director and above were advised to be present on these 75 sites to monitor and perform shramdaan with the general public. DDA also ran campaigns through its social media handles like Twitter and Facebook, informed public about the cleanliness drive at its locations and urged them to participate in the movement.




# II. SPECIAL CAMPAIGN 3.0 AT DDA SPORTS COMPLEXES, PM-UDAY PROCESSING CENTERS
