- The unique transaction reference on RTGS against EMD shall be placed online at specified location for Tender for Electronic Time and Attendance Recording System. First cover containing 1 "Technical Bid" as well as "reference of EMD.
- The technical Bids shall be opened online at 3.30 PM on date 27.06.2025 in the presence of a committee or their representatives by authorized bid openers. Price Bids of only those tenderers 2. shall be opened whose technical bids qualify, at a time and place of which notice will be given. The Tenderer technically qualified will be at liberty to be present either in person or through an authorized representative at the time of opening of the Price Bids with the Bid Acknowledgement Receipt or they can view the bid opening event online at their remote end.
- The tenderer should furnish Rs.1,44,543/- as Earnest Money in the form of RTGS/NEFT. 3.
- The tender shall be submitted online in two parts, viz., technical bid and price bid. 4.
